Addendum to and specification of the Graduate Student Teaching Policy for AY 21/22 September 15, 2021

This guideline extends and specifies CEU's Graduate Student Teaching Policy.

Types of teaching assistants

As per CEU's policy doctoral students must complete a *Teaching Practicum* to satisfy their program requirements. This practicum is unpaid and is the condition for eligibility for serving as paid teaching assistants in the future.

Course assistants and Doctoral Student Tutors are both teaching assistants but the latter has a wider range of responsibilities- as described below in the table. Technical Assistants provide technical support before/ after or during anonline class session.

Part-time positions may also be advertised, if departmental need warrants that.

Hiring procedure

All paid positions must be advertised on this page (https://careernext.ceu.edu/). Job advertisement templates are available from HRO. Departments should contact HRO to post job advertisement. Applications must be submitted to HRO who will create and share a folder for each advertised position with the department. Departments make decisions, notify the students and request the start of contracting from HRO.

Training for Doctoral Student Teaching Assistants specifically focused on supporting teaching online will be provided by the Center for Teaching and Learning. During the academic year doctoral students are encouraged to complete CLT's regular course "Programfor Excellence in Teaching in Higher Education".
